COVID-19 UPDATES AND GUIDANCE ON COVID-19 EFFECTIVE MAY 29, 2021

- The community rooms and common sitting areas will remain closed, except for scheduled and pre-organized events/meetings to continue to be safe until the lifting of the Governor's Emergency Health Order.
- For everyone's safety, Maintenance and Property Management Staff will continue to wear masks when entering resident's units or situations when social distancing is not possible.
- All common areas of the GHA properties will continue to be routinely cleaned and sanitized.
- All visitors are required to wear a mask in the building's common areas (hallways, elevators, and laundry rooms).

VACCINATED?

- Fully vaccinated people can remove their masks both inside and outside of GHA buildings.
- If you've been exposed to someone who has COVID-19 or have traveled outside of the state, you are no longer required to quarantine or get tested for COVID-19 unless you have symptoms.
- The virus is not gone. Be safe, be smart. Wash your hands. Don't touch your face. Clean and disinfect your spaces. Maintain social distance whenever possible.

UNVACCINATED?

- Unvaccinated persons must continue wear masks and social distance at all times in public areas of the GHA buildings, such as lobbies, elevators, hallways, community rooms and laundry rooms.
- Unvaccinated persons can remove their masks when outside of GHA buildings, except when social distancing is not possible.
- You are at high risk for contracting COVID-19 and spreading it to others. Be personally accountable. The virus is not gone. Wash your hands. Don't touch your face. Clean and disinfect your area.
